Dear Fraternity President:

As Penn State's Homecoming Weekend is fast approaching and all of you are busy making plans for your fraternity's homecoming float, it is important to remember how to properly dispose of your float after this year's festivities are over.

It is very important to not throw your entire float into your dumpster.

This could cause injury to one of our drivers or damage to one of our trucks for which you would be held responsible. To dispose of the float it is important to dismantle it and put any lumber, chicken wire, and/or large, bulky items out at the curb or near your dumpster for riff-raff collection.

You can arrange for this type of pick up by calling the Borough's Service Building at 234-7135. Crepe paper and similar small items can be bagged and placed in the dumpster for collection. Remember to clean up all poms promptly before they blow into the street and onto neighboring properties.

Floats need to be disassembled and the materials placed out for collection no later than the Wednesday after homecoming weekend so the Sanitation Department can plan for extra help with the added collection. If you have any questions about the disposal of your float, please contact the Health Department at 234-7191 or by calling the Sanitation Department at 234-7135.

Please remember that failure to follow these guidelines is a violation of Borough ordinance and will result in fines levied against you. Thank you for your cooperation and have a safe Homecoming.
